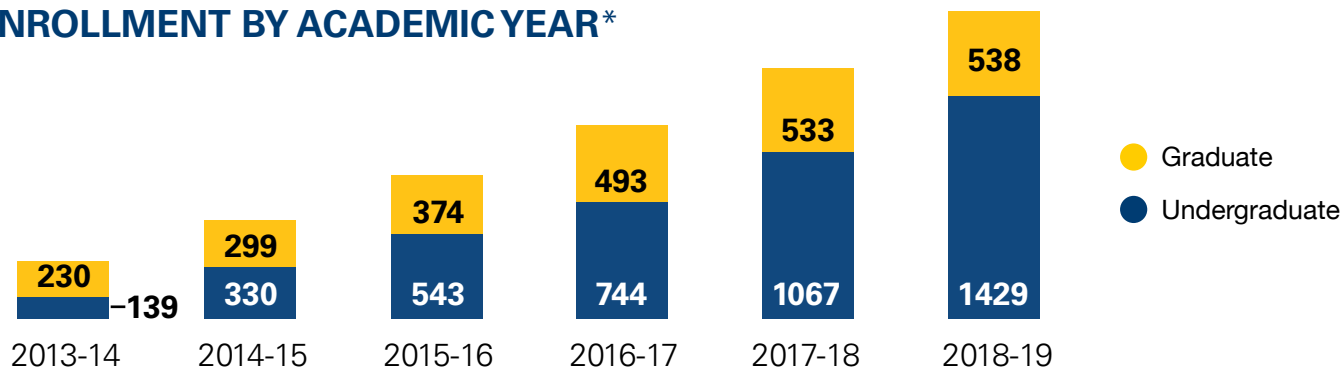

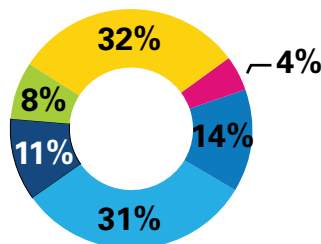

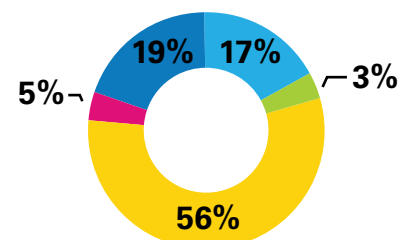

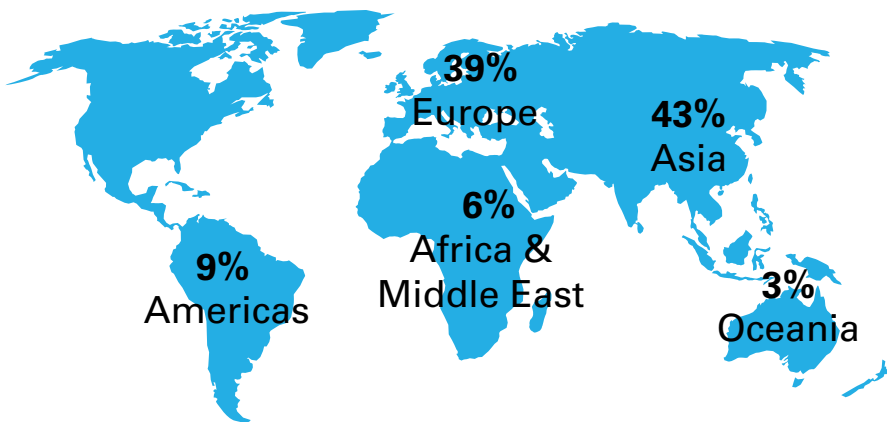

COUNTRIES OF ORIGIN BY REGION



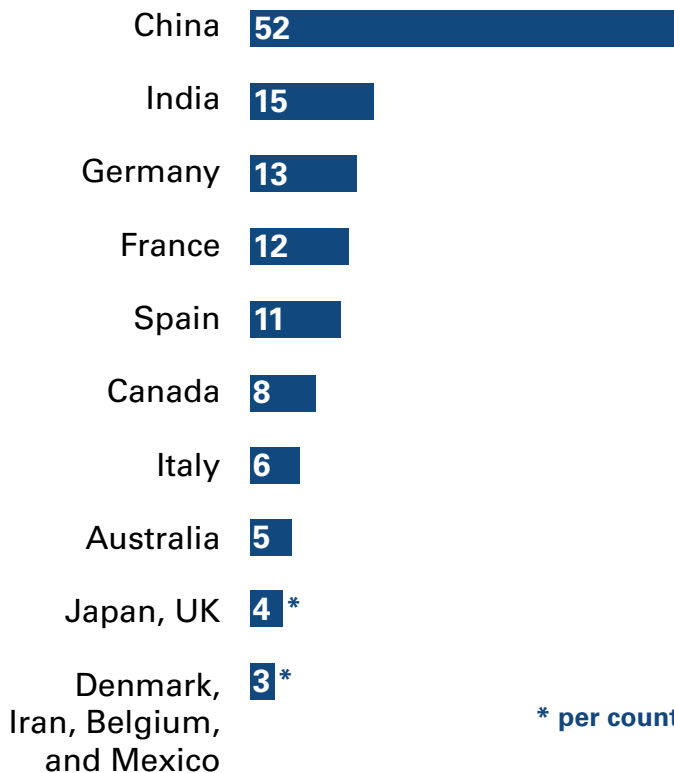

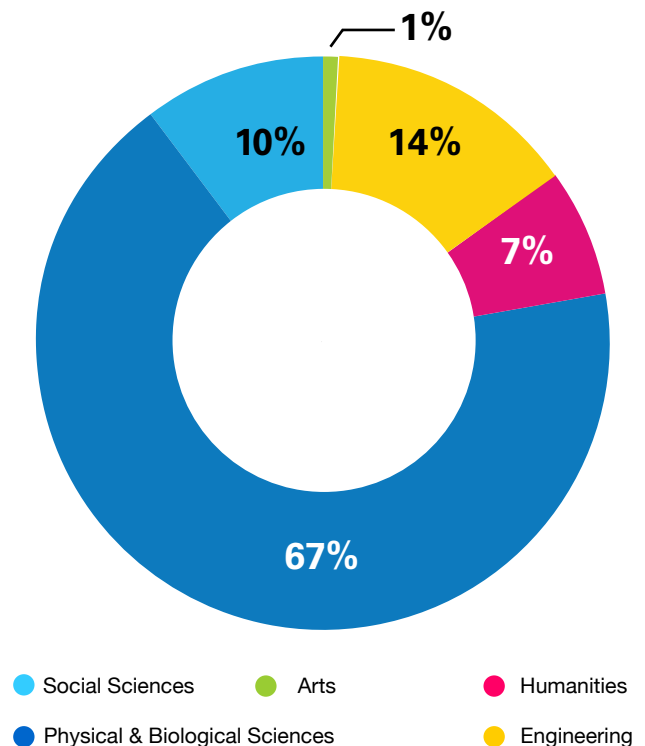

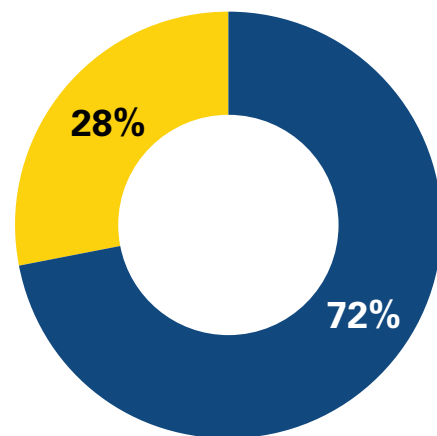

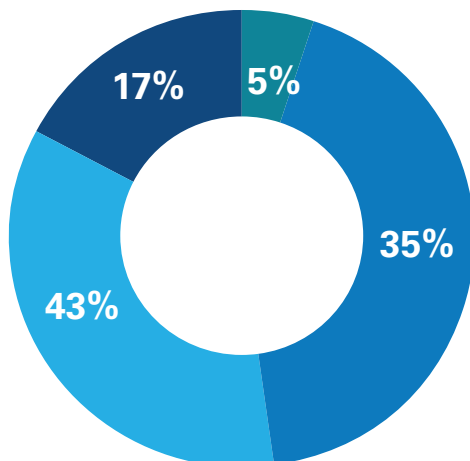

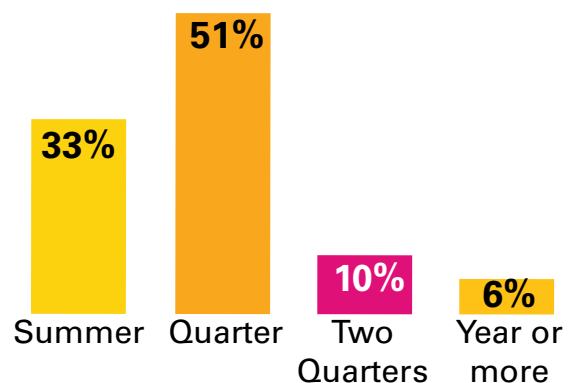
